

Regulations for the reenactors during Ligny 2022

1. Construction/dismantling of camps

The build-up is planned from Thursday to Friday evening

Your location is identified by a number we ask you to respect

The dismantling takes place on Sunday after 16:00 when the vehicles have access to the bivouac.

We will ask you to make vehicles and all forms of anachronism disappear from Saturday 8am

2. Wood/straw/water/hay to use as a good homedad.

Straw is provided to you, unfortunately the quality depends on the climatic conditions of the previous year. Most often, straw is picked up by the machine, do not make heaps.

The wood will only be used for fire and a small provision must be made. The hole in front of the fireplace should be cleaned up with the shovel and sealed well after the bivouac.

The wood must be shared between all the companies present to spend the two nights without running out. Every year there are many unused blocks scattered throughout the site, please clean them up from now on

Water is offered at the tap, it is drinkable. Hay is for horses.

3. Security

We ask each group to carefully check their weapons and other combat items to avoid injury during group animations. A bucket of water should be placed by the fire.

Manufacture powder cartridges in accordance with safety instructions. (no cigarette)

Any unplanned trip on public roads outside those of the organization is the responsibility of the president of the association.

Toilets connected to water are at your disposal, thank you for respecting their state of cleanliness.

4. Animations

Associations should experience their reenactment both during the day and in the evening independently and shared, because the site must absolutely be immersed in a historic atmosphere that should be felt from Friday evening to Sunday 17:00.

Life in a bivouac is part of the animations, you have to be able to play dice or other games, eat, drink, clean your weapons, explain the life of the soldier, cook, discuss with each other and prepare for battle... all this in the presence of visitors.

The tents are visible from the outside, the inside of some can be opened provided it is arranged as in 1815.

The program must be scrupulously respected, as well as the officers responsible for commanding the platoons.

5. Discipline

It is necessary to avoid any anachronism in the bivouac, in the tents, which can be hidden must be.

Modern objects must be hidden.

It is not recommended to brandish weapons, abuse alcoholic beverages on the site during the opening hours for visitors.

This warning applies to prevent accidents. The member of an association who exposes himself in public in a state of drunkenness will expose his group to the final exclusion from the Ligny site.

We will ask the members of the association to respect the silence from 23:00 for the respect of everyone.

Parking is a problem due to lack of available land. We ask you to respect the parking instructions.

Your waste must be left in the places that will be indicated to you.
